What's the scheme about?

Community Lincs' Bulk Oil Buying Scheme is designed to reduce the cost of your domestic heating oil each time you place an order. All you need to do to take advantage of the scheme is to pay an annual membership fee, which will cover as many oil orders as you need during the course of the year.

What's the snag?

There isn't one. The scheme is being promoted by Community Lincs, a long established local charity that works to support community-based action across the county. By bringing communities throughout Lincolnshire together and making the most of joint buying power, we can help you to make savings on your fuel costs.

The environment benefits too?

Every time a tanker comes out to make a delivery, it is using a lot of diesel - a full tanker can get as little as 8 miles per gallon. If deliveries are organised so that the tanker delivers to several customers in the village instead of making lots of individual deliveries, the fuel consumption is reduced and so is traffic in the village.

5 easy steps to cheaper heating oil

Step 1. Join the Community Lincs Scheme

Contact your local co-ordinator, download a membership form from our website or give us a ring. See details below. www.communitylincs.com

Step 2. Wait to hear from your local co-ordinator/Community Lincs

We will let your local co-ordinator know that you have joined the scheme. If your community does not have a co-ordinator we will work with you to identify one.

Step 3. Place an order

Your local co-ordinator will contact you each month to see if you want to buy oil. They will then submit a total village order to us. Your order increases our negotiating power, so once submitted we regard it as binding.

Step 4. Sit back whilst we negotiate the price

We negotiate the best price from a whole range of local and national suppliers. Your local co-ordinator will advise you who the supplier is, the price per litre (exclusive of VAT, currently at 5%) and the date of delivery.

Step 5. Take delivery of the oil and pay the company

The oil will be delivered as soon as possible and you pay the company supplying the oil direct as you would normally do
