Explanatory Notes*

- The Gift Aid scheme is for gifts of money to charities by individuals (including sole traders and partnerships) who pay UK tax
- In order to make a Gift Aid donation you must complete the GIFT AID DECLARATION. This form will cover every gift made to this charity – it can also include gifts previously made as well as future gifts
- Gift Aid increases the value of donations to charities by allowing the charity to reclaim basic rate tax relief on your donations.
- Please note that enough UK tax must have been paid to cover your donations, if not you may be required to repay any shortfall to HMRC, however such donations may be carried back to the previous tax year.
- For donations between 6 April 2008 and 5 April 2011 the charity will also get a separate government supplement of three pence on every pound you give.
- If you claim higher rate tax you can claim extra relief on your donations
- If you claim age related allowances or tax credits, Gift Aid donation can sometimes increase your entitlement
