What are apprenticeships?

Apprenticeships combine work with practical, on and off-the-job training and study. An apprentice is employed, working alongside a mentor to gain the skills, knowledge and behaviours needed to be fully competent in their chosen occupation. Anyone can become an apprentice at any age and benefit from government funding to support their apprenticeship. This applies whether they're already employed in your company or not, and whether they are employed full or part-time.

Ixion apprenticeships are delivered using a blended learning model with a combination of remote delivery using MS Teams and face to face delivery.
